Purpose of the role

Responsibilities: Medical Doctors Specialists in Oncological Radiotherapy is responsible for the clinical execution of the treatments.

In particular:

- the implementation of the 'justification principle' according with regulatory (evaluating individually the indication and the opportunity to carry out the radiation treatment, choosing, if necessary, and motivating this decision, to carry out this treatment as an alternative to other consolidated treatments, considering the proper protocols/guidelines, recommendations and scientific research evidencies)
- individual target volumes' planning, to be treated considering that doses at non-target volumes and tissues should be as low as reasonably achievable and compatible with the radiotherapy aim to be reached
- the use of appropriate immobilization systems and appropriate treatment techniques
- the clinical results evaluation, pre-during-post treatment
- cooperation with other specialists and with personnel who may be delegated for practical aspects
- informing patients about the risks associated with the prescribed radiation treatment
- participation in updates of therapeutic protocols and Quality
- professional updating in accordance with the training plan
